# Platoon Raid

## ◎ Task/Organization for an Ambush

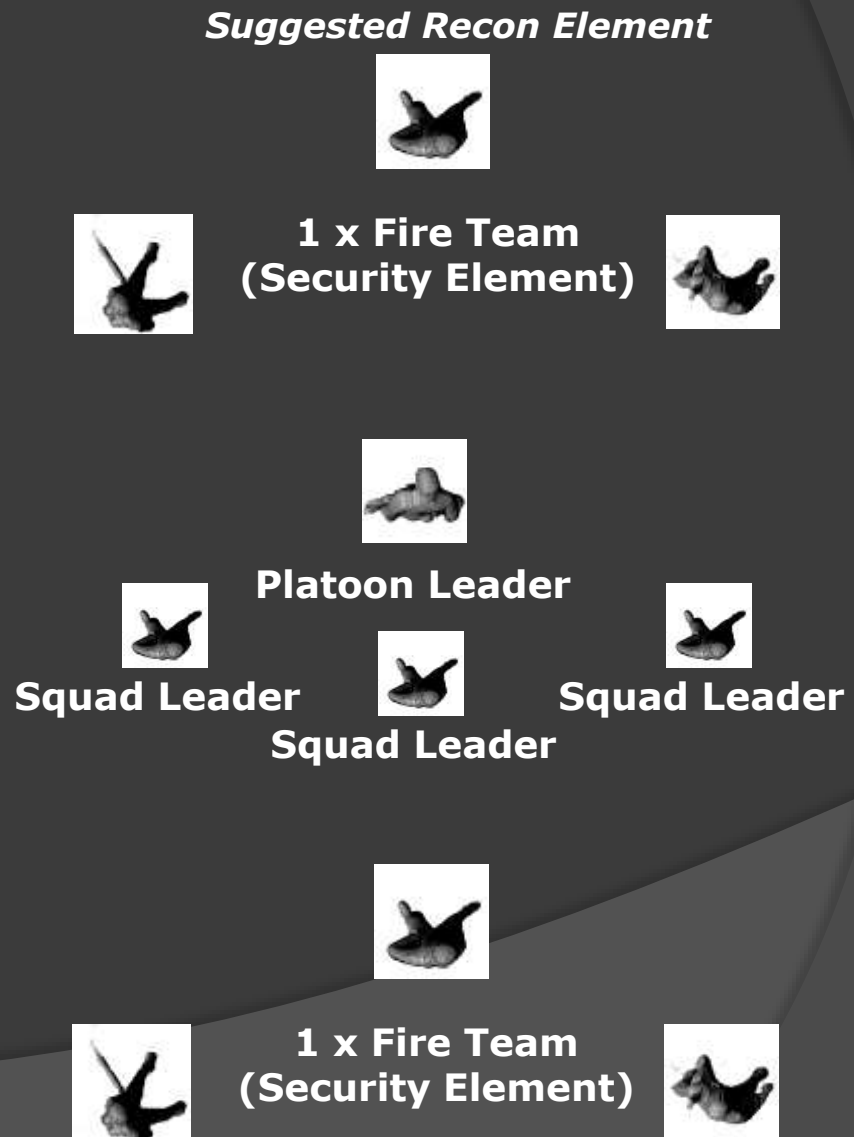
- Security Element – 1 x Squad (4-8 personnel)
- Support Element – 1 x WPNs Squad (4-8 personnel)
- 2 x Assault Elements – 1 x Squad each (6-8 personnel each)

## ◎ Leadership Locations

- Platoon Leader is positioned behind the Assault Squads
- Platoon Sergeant is positioned with the WPNs Squad
- All Squad Leaders are positioned with their Squads

# STEP 1: Leader's Recon

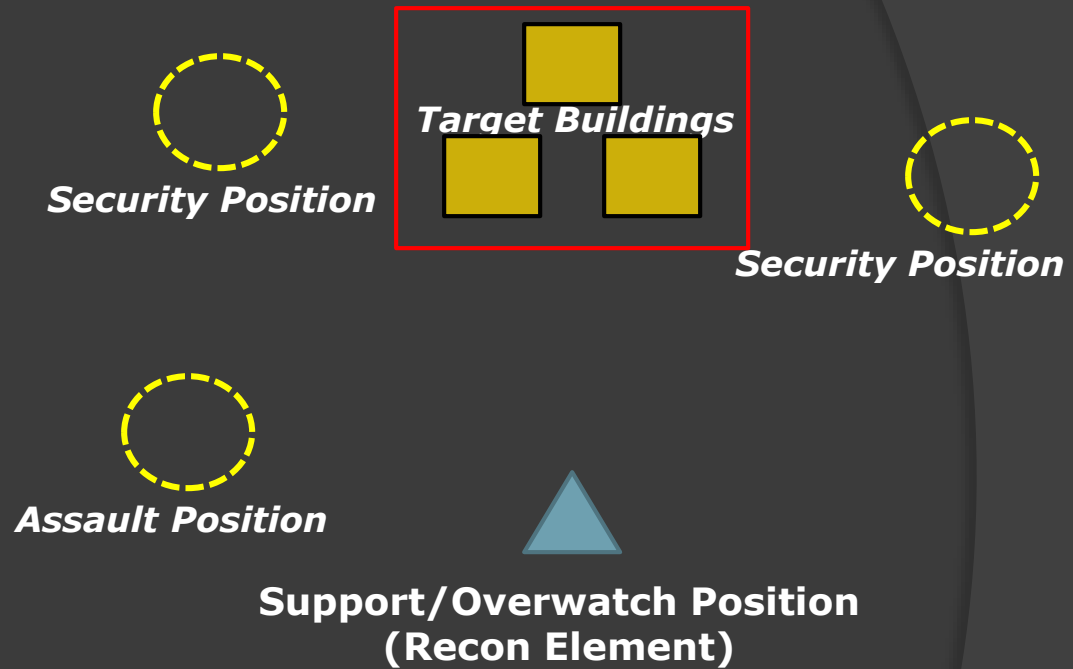
- Vital to determine best location for all elements and confirm location of the raid
- Confirmation: ensure the ENY or Intel, likely or suspected, is at the correct location.
- Platoon Leader must move forward of the Platoon with a small group to do necessary Recon



# STEP 2: Occupy

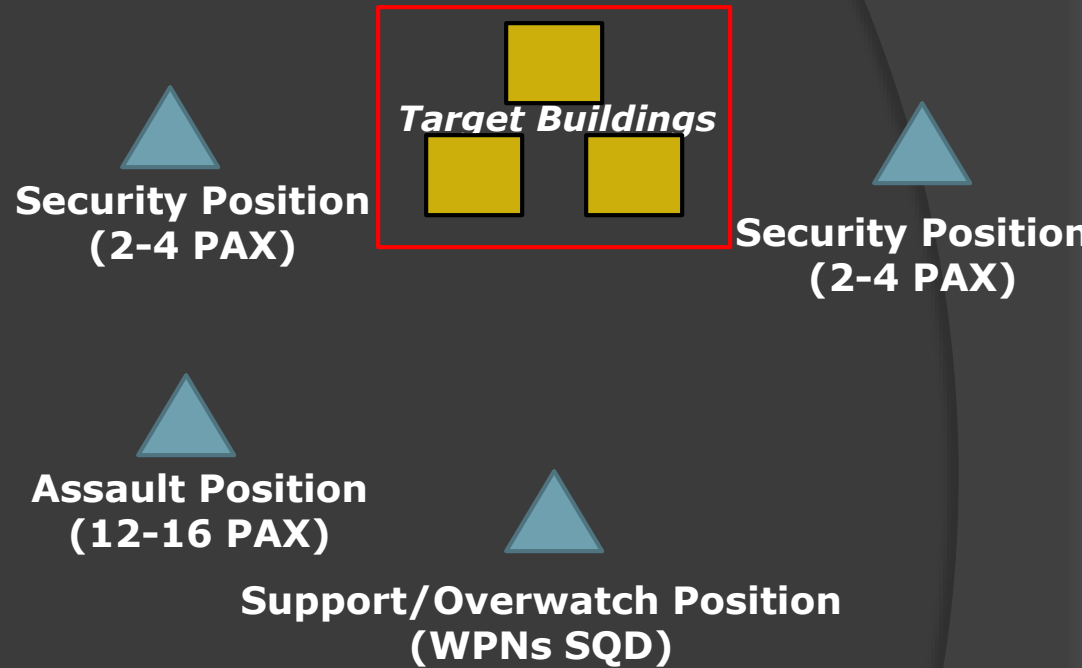
## Support/Overwatch Position

- Locate and occupy Support/Overwatch position
- Confirm Target Buildings/Location
- Determine where the Security and Assault Elements need to be placed
- Call forward remainder of platoon



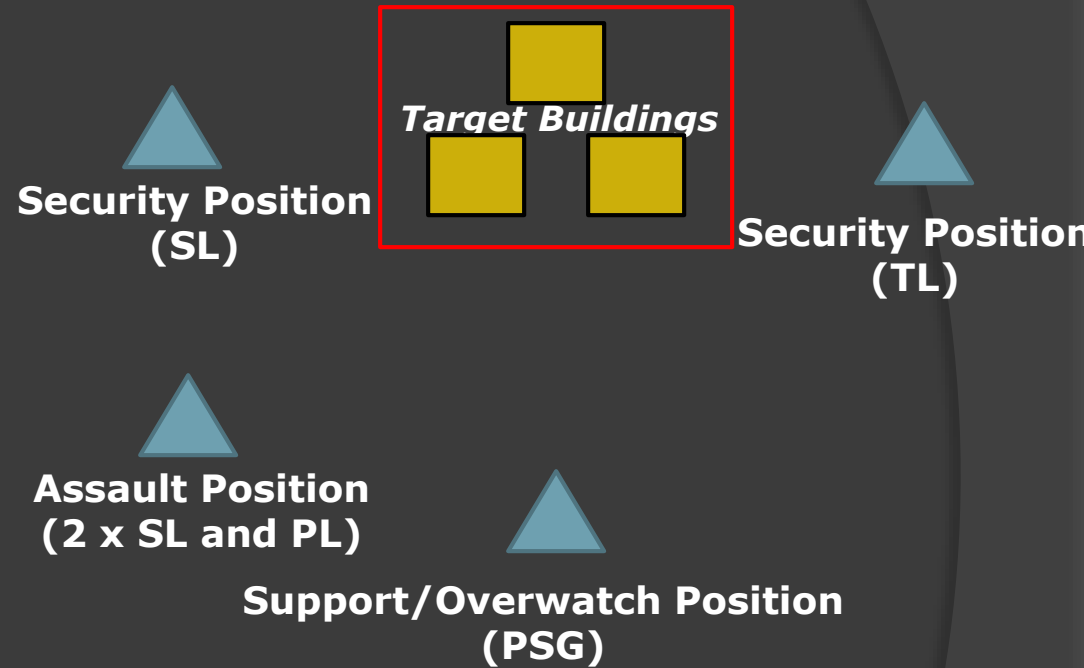
# STEP 3: Occupy Security and Assault Positions

- Move Security Element into the two Security Positions
- Move the remainder of the WPNs SQD into Support/Overwatch Position
- Move Assault Element into Assault Position (Note: Assault positions can be in separate locations if need be)



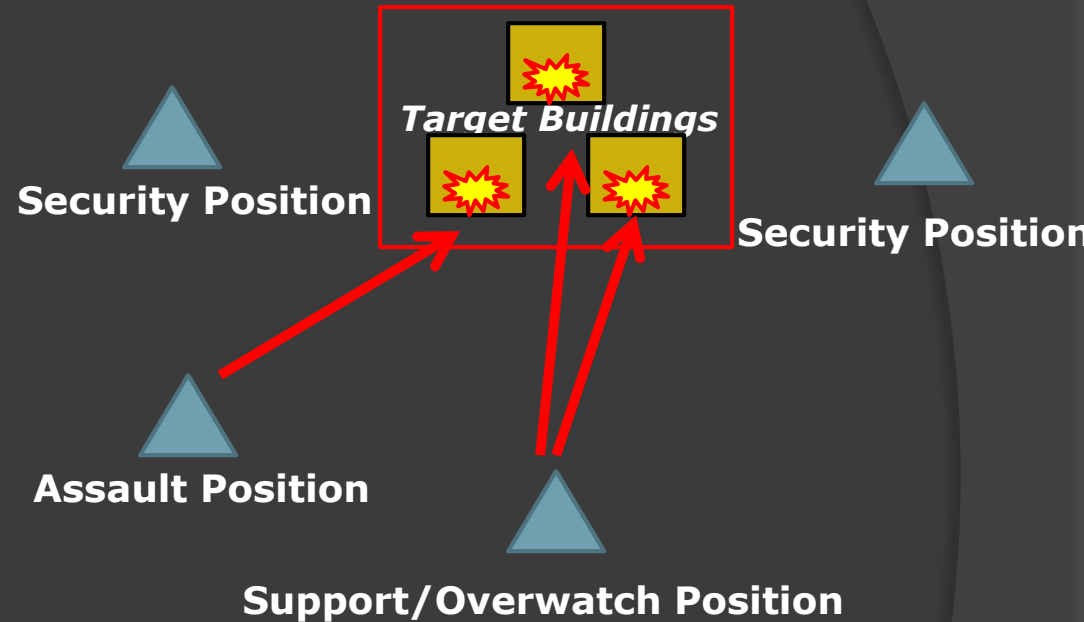
# STEP 4: Leaders Position with Elements

- Platoon Leader moves to Assault Position
- Platoon Sergeant moves to Support Position
- Squad Leaders located with Squads
  - Note: Security Element will require a Team Leader to be with the other position



# STEP 5: Initiate Raid

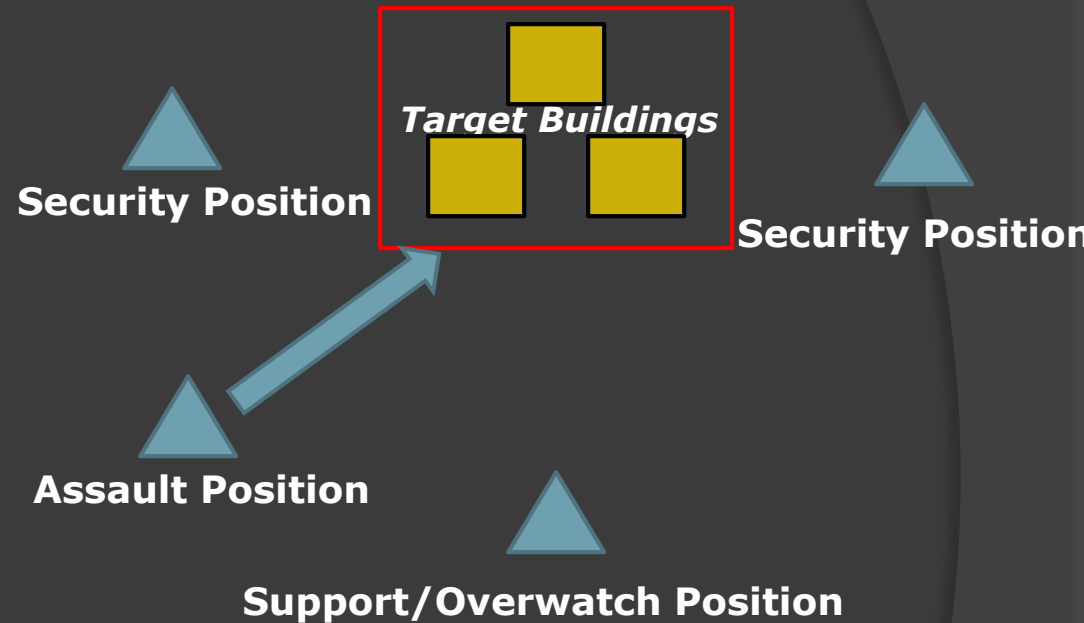
- Platoon Leader designates where each position will direct their fires
- Platoon Leader initiates the fires with determined signal
- Support and Assault Positions fire on enemy for 1 minute, wait 30 seconds, and fire for another 30 seconds





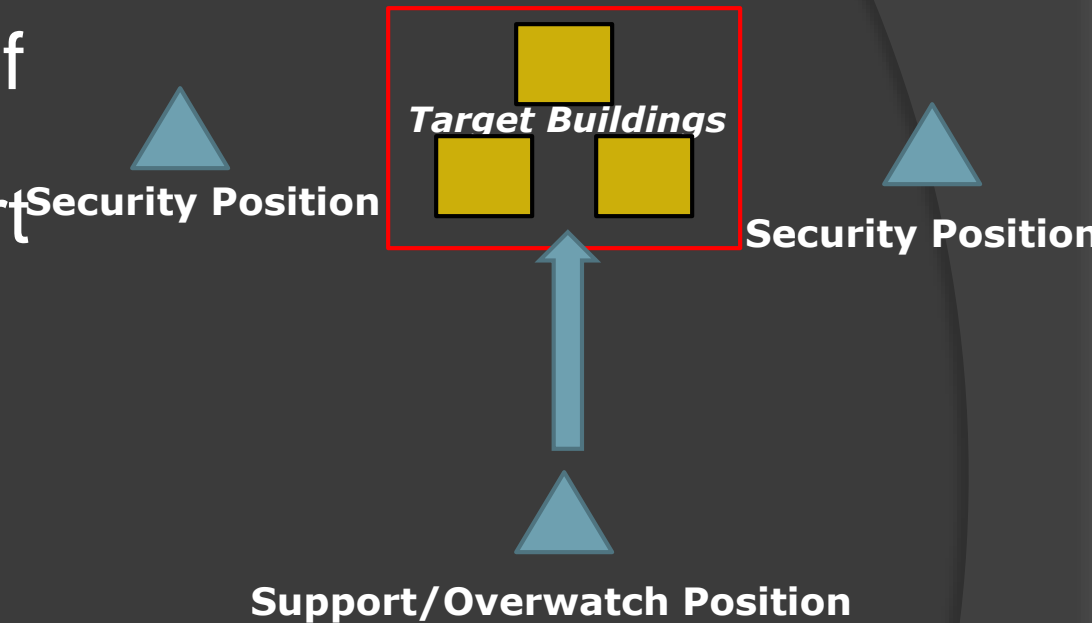
# STEP 6: Assault the Objective

- One Assault Element picks up and moves through Kill Zone
- Assault establishes foothold in the building
- Second Assault Element picks up and clears building
- The Assault Elements continue to leap frog through buildings



# STEP 7: Reconsolidation

- Once buildings declared cleared or if more personnel are required, the Support position moves onto the Objective
- The Security positions stays set and prepares to repeal reinforcements
- Medic creates Casualty Collection Point (CCP) and treats casualties



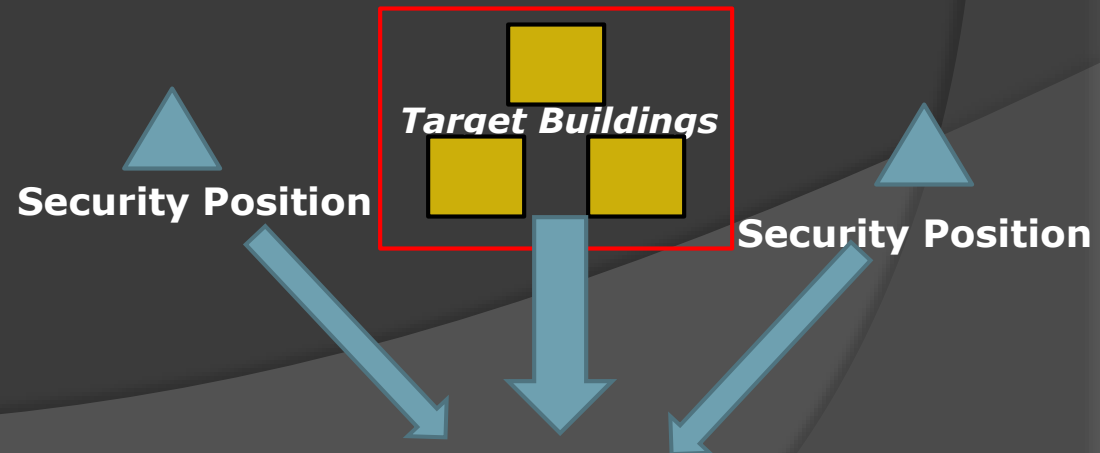
# STEP 8: Defense or EXFIL

- If the Platoon is tasked with defense, Security positions move onto the objective



OR

- If the Platoon is tasked to EXFIL and conduct a new mission, Security positions pick up as the Platoon leaves objective area



# Platoon Raid Tips:

- Communication plan is vital for success. Use multiple signals in case of radios failure (e.g. whistle, hand signal, voice, etc)
- Always in place the Support/Overwatch Position first
- Listen for noises of movement when conducting the initiation cease fire (30 seconds). This will help pin point ENY personnel when engaging again
- The foothold is the most important part of the Raid. Without establishing one, the clearance of the Objective will not occur
